Concordia University Fitness Facility Offers Training & Wellness Opportunities

Located in Riverside, Ill., Concordia University near Chicago is an institution rooted in Christian heritage. It offers more than 100 undergraduate and graduate programs in arts & sciences, business, and education. In addition to its extensive academic offerings, the University also has a substantial athletic presence, boasting 14 varsity sports teams.

In November of 2013, Concordia University underwent a significant renovation to its Fitness Facility, designed to be used by the whole community, including students, staff, and athletes. The weight equipment and track were designed specifically with athletics in mind. Given the importance of strength and conditioning in the overall training regime of collegiate athletes, the University realized it was time to make upgrades.

The design of the new facility called for some dramatic changes. The previous space was a pool facility that was then converted to a fitness facility, and the space was significantly expanded.

Erin Masters, an interior designer at Holabird & Root, the firm hired to design the new fitness center, noted that durability and

maintenance are two main considerations when deciding on flooring for fitness areas, especially those used by collegiate sports teams. In addition to withstanding the frequency of dropped weights, the floors needed to be easy-to-clean for maintenance purposes. With those considerations in mind, Spartan Surfaces, the company heavily involved in the flooring selection, suggested Ecore. of Performance UltraTile was installed in the weight rack area, and another 160square-feet of Performance UltraTile (Custom Logo with Red and Yellow) was installed under weight racks. Masters noted the custom red and yellow water jet logo, featuring the University's cougar mascot, "turned out beautifully."

Designed with a patented "ultra" wear layer on a molded base to provide unlimited design options, Performance UltraTile is ideal in weight rooms, because it offers enhanced shock absorption against impact in weight drops.
